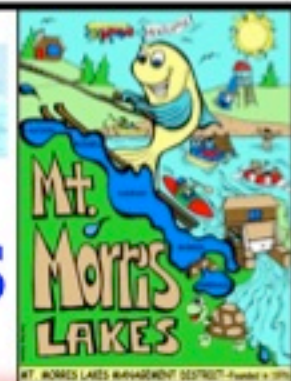

REGULATIONS

THESE LAKES ARE NO WAKE LAKES Beginning **5:00 PM** & Ending **10:00 AM** Every Day, Weekends, & Holidays

BOATING BEHAVIOR ADVISORY: Low to moderate activity is recommended for these lakes. Use common sense: High performance personal watercraft maneuvers & high boating activity in crowded conditions (more than 7 boats) are not appropriate for safety reasons. While a behavior might be "legal," it may not be a "safe and appropriate" behavior for these small lakes. Aggressive boating behavior & making large wakes harms shorelines and threatens boater safety.

WATER SKIING IS PERMITTED ONLY ON **MORRIS LAKE** FROM 10:00 AM TO 5:00 PM

In a Safe, Counter-Clockwise Rotation Around the Lake

NO WAKE AT ALL TIMES THROUGH ALL LAKE CHANNELS
Full wake boating only is permitted on all other lakes: Alfson, Russell, Hannah, and Morris 10:00 am – 5:00 pm, all days, all holidays

**EMERALD LAKE IS A
NO WAKE, IDLE SPEED ONLY LAKE... AT ALL TIMES**

PERSONAL WATERCRAFT ADVISORY:

No Wake Within 200 Feet of Shores
and Within **100 Feet** of Other Boats & PWC's

*It is illegal to have another boat create a wake for a PWC to jump over.
Lakes Alfson, Russell, & Hannah have limited full wake PWC use*

No Wake Within 100 Feet of the Public Swim Area
